FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

The following FAQ provides information on requesting reasonable accommodations in Poquonnock Bridge Fire District's programs and activities.

1. What is reasonable accommodation in the Poquonnock Bridge Fire District's program?

A reasonable accommodation is a change or modification to afford a qualified individual with a disability full enjoyment of PBFD's programs or activities, unless modifications of policies, practices, and procedures would fundamentally alter the nature of the program, service, or activity, or result in undue financial and administrative burdens to the Poquonnock Bridge Fire District.

2. How do I request a reasonable accommodation?

You may request a reasonable accommodation from the Poquonnock Bridge Fire District at any time. However, making the request in advance of a meeting, conference call, or visit will help ensure that the Poquonnock Bridge Fire District is able to fulfill the request of an accommodation. For certain requests, such as request for sign language interpretation, the Poquonnock Bridge Fire District requests at least two week's advance notice.
